- Lisa Conley, Chief Administrative Officer of Peaches Pantry talked to the St. Stephen's community outreach group last Monday, about their mission and how they are providing weekend food for school children during the school year. They cover 16 schools in the area and are taking on three more this fall. Later the group discussed outreach planning and decided to focus on the needs of children; this does not preclude other, on going or new, outreach activities. The community Outreach committee will present plans at the next vestry meeting and invites everyone from the congregation to comment and make suggestions.
- This Saturday Jun 23 9 noon Fr. John Christopher is presenting a Recovery Workshop. Workshop topics will cover substance abuse education, spiritual consequences of addiction, open discussion and Q & A sessions. Recovery both spiritual and physical is Fr. John's main ministry as both the Director of Recovery Ministries for the state of Arizona and a board member of the Recovery Ministries of the Episcopal Church (RMEC). A statement that would define John's work with addiction and recovery would be, "anyone can recover if they base their recovery in a spiritual journey.
