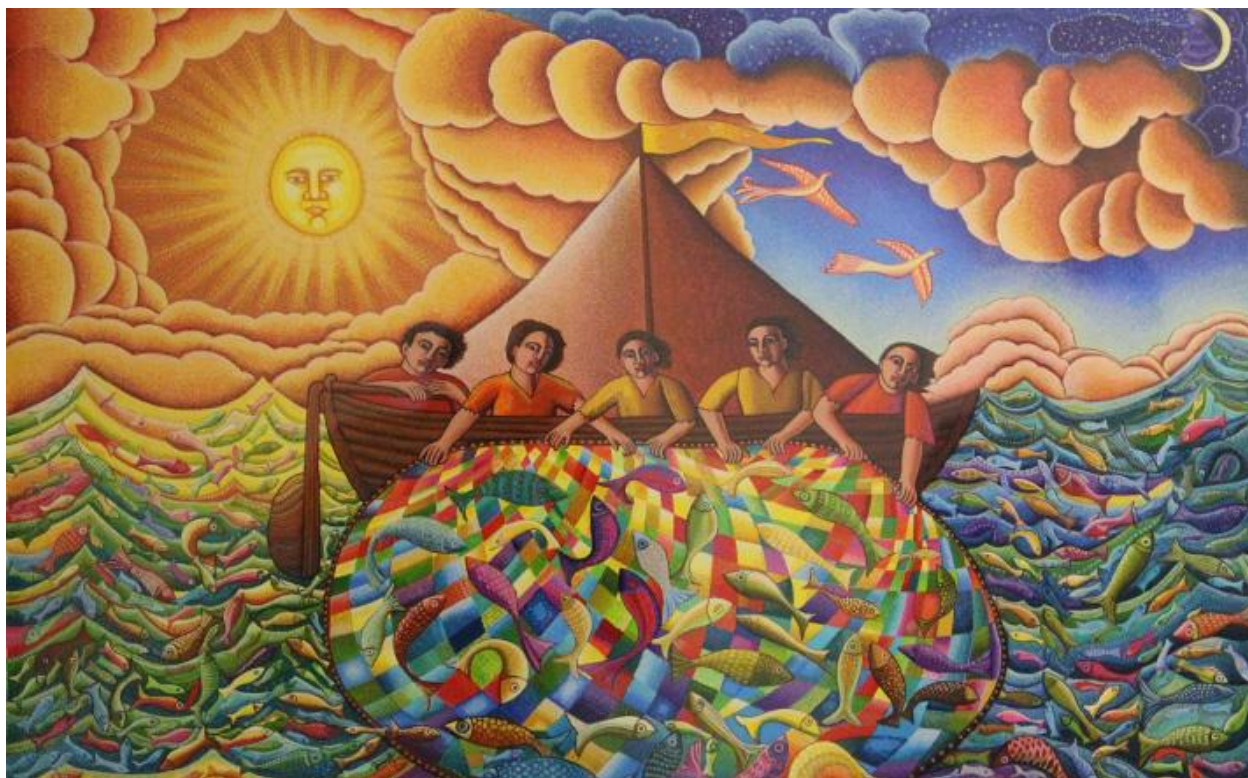


Announcements

- **Groceries 4 U program:** We've had to turn a couple of clients away this past week; we are out of grocery cards. In the past year and a half we have helped 20 local people; some just got out of prison and needed help staying over, some were laid off during the government shutdown others are having trouble finding work because of their age and health. if you can spare any amount it would help our fund and get help to those left behind.
