- Columbarium Expansion We recently sold our last 2 niches in the columbarium. We have contracted with a cabinet maker to build an expansion that will max out the available space. We have also assessed local columbarium prices and find that ours have not kept up with inflation. The vestry has agreed to raise prices on our niches from \$300.00 per person to \$450.00; still less than many other columbaria (i.e. the Southern Arizona Veterans Memorial Cemetery charges \$700.00 per person). This increase will go into effect November 1st 2019. If you would like to purchase a niche at the current price, you can do so up to November 1st. The new cabinets will sport 10 double niches to accommodate two people. Those will be along the bottom of the cabinets.
- We continue to seek a new organist or pianist. We thank Sharon Douglas and Doreen Oberg for filling in as our accompanists. Please continue to pray that we find the right person for our church.
