- Remember we are in Phase II now. This means we can have up to 25 people at each service. However, we are still observing all safety guidelines, i.e. masks, no singing and keep 6 ft distance. It also means that we won't be using the attendance schedule unless we spike again. So you are free to attend any of our 3 weekly services.
- Please take your bulletin home, we are not reusing them during the Covid-19 situation.
- From the Senior Warden: St Stephen's congregants, our irrigation system suffers from a leaking problem. We are waiting on further details from two potential companies. The church has a two hose pipes we can use to water the flowers; one just south of the sidewalk leading into the church and the other on the west side of the Education Center. Could members of the congregation water these plants until the irrigation system is fixed? You could come whenever is convenient to you. Thank you!!!

This will allow the people who are scheduled to come alternating weekends to receive communion at least once a month.

 follow our usual service liturgy up through the exchange of peace and then conclude with the
 Lord's Prayer. These services will be led by lay members of our church.
