From our Rector:

Blessings to you,

I hope this letter finds you doing well this spring. We had a wonderful Easter sunrise service last month and we are in the Easter season until May 23rd which will be the celebration of Pentecost. We have just been granted permission from the Bishop to take a few more steps that inch us closer to a full re-opening.



The latest steps begin May 1st and allow us to do the following:

- 1) Sing! With masks on and staying 6ft apart
- 2) Receive communion in both kinds, bread and wine, through intinction (dipping bread into wine by the priest)
- 3) Have outdoor fellowship time with refreshments, staying socially distant.

We are allowed to go up to 50 people in person if we can still maintain social distancing, this would be a strain for us and unlikely for our worship space. We can probably handle about 35 people with 6ft social distancing.

I am encouraged by the numbers of our members who have been vaccinated and I know these numbers help our overall national goal of reaching "herd immunity." As we move closer to that goal, the restrictions will continue to be loosened. I hope that this summer we can return to our "normal" way of being church, which will make masks optional, and we can return to indoor gatherings of all kinds.

We are in the home stretch for this pandemic in our community. Please stay focused and keep adhering to the guidelines as we strive to reach the finish line.

Episcopal Diocese of Arizona helping churches get solar power panels.

The diocese is doing the initial work to find the best deal on installers, find suitable financing, and provide a no-obligation on-site assessment for each church to determine best location for panels. St. Stephen's is looking for a few individuals to be the church "Solar Team" for this effort. Jr. Warden Sherry Simon has already agreed to be part of this team. The team will coordinate with the diocese for the site visit and will present the information about this plan to the vestry/church when completed.
