We welcome you to our combined Creation Care and Stewardship season at the church. The Episcopal Church and our diocese have been actively promoting attention for how we care for God's creation which God entrusted to us as stewards. Churches observe a "season" (several weeks) focused on ways that we can be better caretakers of God's creation. We have chosen to celebrate our creation care season in conjunction with our stewardship season because they are intimately tied together.
