From our Rector:

Happy Valentine's Month,



We have this celebration of Valentine's Day on the 14th, named for one of three possible priest in ancient Roman times named Valentine. Each priest has their own legends associated with them, but all appear to have been sympathetic, heroic, and romantic figures. The third of which in writing a love letter signed it, "From Your Valentine" – a notation in use today when love notes or cards are sent for the occasion.

The date of Valentine's Day seems to have been selected by the church to influence or overtake a Roman holiday called Lupercalia on 15 February. The Roman holiday was one which used pagan practices to promote fertility for the coming spring, including among women. One practice included available young ladies putting their name in a jar and the men then choosing names and thereby starting a year of consorting with the lady whose name was chosen and these pairings often ended in marriage.

By the Middle Ages, observance of Valentine's Day was established as a day of love and romance, in part because it was widely believed that mid-February was when birds began mating, adding to the idea of a time for love and romance. Written notes began to appear in the 1400s and printed cards became used in the 1800s.

Other gifts that are often given on Valentine's Day include chocolates and roses. Chocolate was once thought to be an aphrodisiac, to stir a person's passions. Red roses have long been a symbol of love and passion dating back to the Roman empire. White roses were a symbol of purity and pink roses are a blend of red and white.

Cupid as a symbol of Valentine's Day has roots in Greek mythology as the Greek God of love Eros, who would shoot golden arrows into people to cause them to fall in love (or leaden arrows to cause people aversion to another person).

With love in mind this February, we begin the Lenten season on Feb 22nd with Ash Wednesday services. It is a time to consider God's love for us in sending us Jesus his son... our own in-person message of love, our own in-person Valentine. May we think on how much God loves us as we move through this month and into the next in our Lenten journey to the cross and the Easter resurrection.
