


Are you curious about what the 12-steps used in various support groups are all about?

Holy Week Schedule in early April: April 2nd is Palm Sunday11 am, April 6th is Maundy Thursday 6pm with Agape Meal worship service, April 7th is Good Friday 6pm with new stations of the cross, April 8th is Easter Vigil at 5pm, and April 9th is Easter Sunday with Easter Brunch in Parish Hall.

The new flooring and parking lot will be a sizable investment in the future of our church. We have received anonymous donations for part of this work, we have savings in the building maintenance fund for part of the work. We would also like your donations to offset the cost and allow us to keep a reasonable reserve for emergency needs in building maintenance. Vestry approved a change to Sunday Worship hour to be 10AM starting May 7th. Many asked if we could move our worship time on Sunday to an earlier time now that Rev. Allison is no longer supporting St. Raphael's in Benson. The unanimous vote was for a 10AM service on Sundays.
