## Call to Confession (Please stand, as you are able)

Presider: Dear Lord, we come to you this evening to express our distance and

confusion regarding our relationship with you:

**People:**

Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation: through your goodness we have this wine to set before you, fruit of the vine and work of human hands. May it become for us the cup of salvation. Blessed be God for ever.

Therefore, Father, with this bread and this cup we celebrate his love, his death, and his risen life. As you feed us with these gifts, send your Holy Spirit (+), and change us more and more to be like Jesus our Savior.

Help us, Father, to love one another, as we look forward to that day when suffering is ended, sorrow is no more, every tear is wiped away, and all creation is gathered together in your loving arms.

And now with our friends and family who have died and who have joined the company of all your saints: we give you glory, through Jesus Christ, in the strength of the Spirit, today and forever. **AMEN.**

Grant that this holy communion may be to us a comfort in our distress, and a pledge of our inheritance in that kingdom where there is no death, neither sorrow nor crying, but fullness of joy with all your saints, through Jesus Christ our Savior. Amen.
