


# The Greeting



**The Lessons from Scripture** (please be seated for the lessons)

#### First Reading: from the book of Isaiah (16:1-5):

"Send a lamb to the ruler of the land, from Sela, from the wilderness, to the mount of Daughter Zion.

And it will be that like a wandering bird pushed from the nest, so shall the daughters of Moab be at the fords of the Arnon.

Receive counsel, daughter; grant justice; make your shade like night at the midpoint of moon, daughter.

Daughter, shelter the outcasts, the fugitive, do not expose.

Let them settle among you, daughter, the outcasts of Moab; be a shelter to them from the destroyer." For when the violence is no more, and destruction has ceased, and those who trample have vanished from the land,

then in faithful love shall a throne be established and on it one shall sit in faithfulness in the tent of David, rendering judgment and seeking justice and swift to do right.

- 11 The counsel of the JUST ONE stands for all time, the thoughts of her heart to all generations.
- 12 Happy is the nation for whom the CREATOR OF ALL is their God, the people whom she has chosen as her heritage.
- 13 From the heavens the MOST HIGH looks down; she sees all the woman-born.
- 14 From her eternal throne she gazes upon

all who dwell upon the earth.

Moreover, reading this, you all will be able to comprehend my understanding of the mystery of Christ. In former generations this mystery was not made known to the woman-born, as it has now been revealed to the women and men who are God's holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit: that is, the Gentiles have become coinheritors, are of the same body, and sharers in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.

# Sermon (Keith Saare)

The Nicene Creed All say together

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through him all things were made.

For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven: by the power of the Holy Spirit he became incarnate from the Virgin Mary, and was made man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets.

We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church.

We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

### **Prayers of the People**

- Leader: Let us pray to God, who is made manifest in Jesus Christ. As the prophet Isaiah rang out, "Arise, shine; for your light has come";
- People: Empower your Church, O God, to ring out the Good News of the Light of your son Jesus, which pierces even the deepest darkness.
- Leader: As a star rose high into the nighttime sky to draw the nations to the Christ-child;
- People: send your blessing, O God, on this nation, and every nation, and draw the whole world to your peace and truth.

- People: we pray for those we love and who have answered your call to follow Jesus into your Heavenly Kingdom. Give them your peace.
- Leader: In the Anglican cycle of prayer, we pray for **The Anglican Church of Southern Africa.** In the diocesan cycle of prayer we pray for **St. Raphael in the Valley, Benson**. With honor and respect we remember the first peoples of this land, especially the Apache and Tohono O'odham, who call this area home.

#### People: May God bless and keep them healthy and protected.

Presider: Lord Jesus, Light of the World, hear our prayers, and make us reflections of your Light, that the places of darkness in our world would be pierced by your Light, and that all nations would be drawn to you and be overwhelmed with joy. **Amen.**

The Great Thanks giving

We give thanks to you, O God, for the goodness and love which you have made known to us in creation; in the calling of Israel to be your people; in your Word spoken through the prophets; and above all in the Word made flesh, Jesus, your Son.

For in these last days you sent him to be incarnate from the Virgin Mary, to be the Savior and Redeemer of the world. In him, you have delivered us from evil, and made us worthy to stand before you. In him, you have brought us out of error into truth, out of sin into righteousness, out of death into life.

On the night before he died for us, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when he had given thanks to you, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, and said,:

"Take, eat: This is my Body, which is given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me."

After supper he took the cup of wine; and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, and said,

"Drink this, all of you: This is my Blood of the new Covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this for the remembrance of me."

Therefore, according to his command, O Father,

#### We remember his death, We proclaim his resurrection, We await his coming in glory;

And we offer our sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving to you, O Lord of all; presenting to you, from your creation, this bread and this wine.

We pray you, gracious God, to send your Holy Spirit upon these gifts (+) that they may be the Sacrament of the Body of Christ and his Blood of the new Covenant.

Unite us to your Son in his sacrifice, that we may be acceptable through him, being sanctified (+) by the Holy Spirit.

In the fullness of time, put all things in subjection under your Christ, and bring us to that heavenly country where, with all your saints, we may enter the everlasting heritage of your sons and daughters; through Jesus Christ our Lord, the firstborn of all creation, the head of the Church, and the author of our salvation.

By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit all honor and glory is yours, Almighty Father, now and forever. **AMEN**.

And now as our savior Christ has taught us, we are bold to say:

The Lord's Prayer:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy Name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.
