Greetings! You are receiving this email because you have signed up for St. Stephen's Groceries 4 U program. Due to the current US economic situation, which has exponentially increased requests for help, St. Stephen's has made a tough decision to reduce the amounts for both individuals and families. Where we used to give \$30 per 30-day period for individuals we will now be giving \$20 per 30-day period and where we used to give \$50 per 30-day period for families it will now be \$40 per 30-day period. Disbursements will cease until July 1st to give us enough time to make changes and test the software. Disbursements will resume Wednesday, July 1st.
